If you're a nonprofessional volunteer that has been assigned by our FBC RAM team to a specific area, choose "General Support" in the first drop-down menu and "Community" Host Group" in the second drop-down menu. If you haven't been assigned to a specific area by our FBC RAM team, choose "General Support" in the first drop-down menu and "General Support" in the second drop-down menu, and RAM will assign you an area to serve on the day of the clinic when you check in at Volunteer Registration. 4) Events & Assignments: Choose "USA: Tennessee" in the first drop-down menu, "clinics" in the second drop-down menu, and "Clinton, TN 2024" in the third drop-down menu. 5) Add your digital signature to the liability waiver & click "save signature". 6) click "save & submit" at the bottom of the page. If you have trouble with this process, Kevin & Amanda will be available to help you register after church services (in the FLC lobby after the 8:30 service & in the Garden Room after the 10:40 service) on the following Sundays: Aug. 25, Sept. 1 (combined 8:30 service-FLC lobby only), & Sept. 29. If you are a dental professional or volunteer over the age of 18 and wish to serve on the dental floor, you must complete your blood-borne pathogen certification. Children under the age of 14 can't register to volunteer. Guardians of volunteers ages 14-18 must either be on site or give permission to an assigned FBC volunteer to act as guardian.
